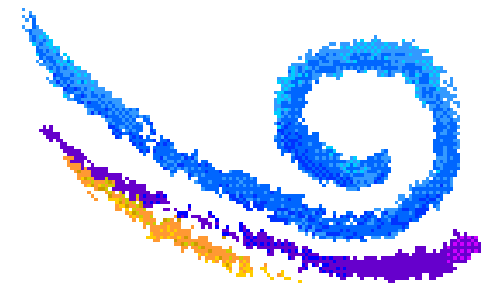

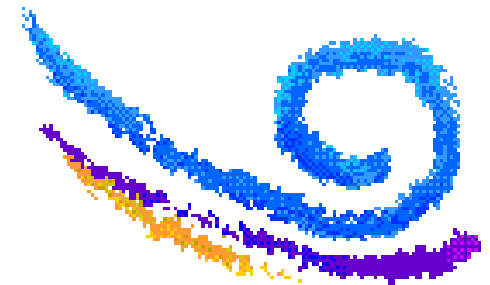
Modern IBM Mainframes - Operating System

- ▶ An evolution that allows change yet supports continuity
 - OS/360 - single address space, 24-bit addressing
 - OS/VS1, OS/VS2 - virtual storage on IBM mainframes
 - MVS - multiple address spaces
 - MVS/XA - 31 bit addressing
 - OS/390 - closer software component integration
 - z/OS - 64 bit addressing



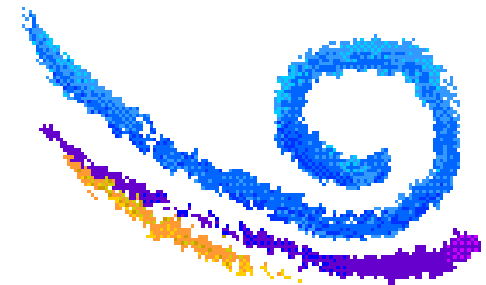
Operating System - Some Included Features

- ▶ UNIX System Services - run UNIX on the mainframe
- ▶ TCP/IP - communicate to the internet
- ▶ HTTP Server - serve your own web pages
- ▶ Language Environment - common run time environment
- ▶ SMTP - email server



Modern IBM Mainframes - Cashing In

- ▶ Most effective use of your IT dollars...
 - Use facilities already on the mainframe you have in house
 - Upgrade to the current hardware (z/Architecture) and software (z/OS) to use new facilities
 - Train your current mainframe staff on updated and new facilities
 - They know your business and your data
 - Inspire them by your commitment to them
